


Once upon a time, there was a pond

“Ribbit!”

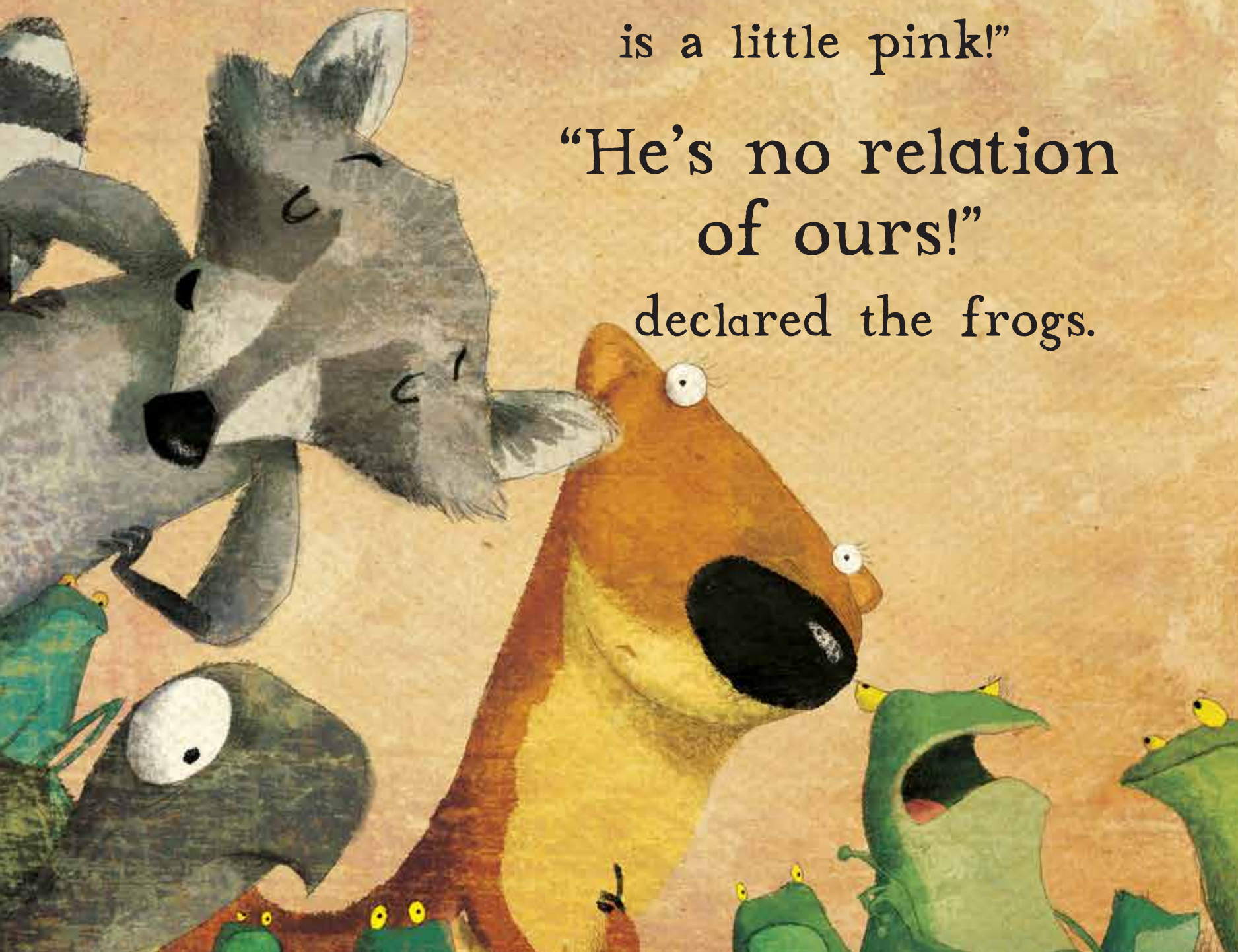


News of the little pig who thought

is a little pink!”

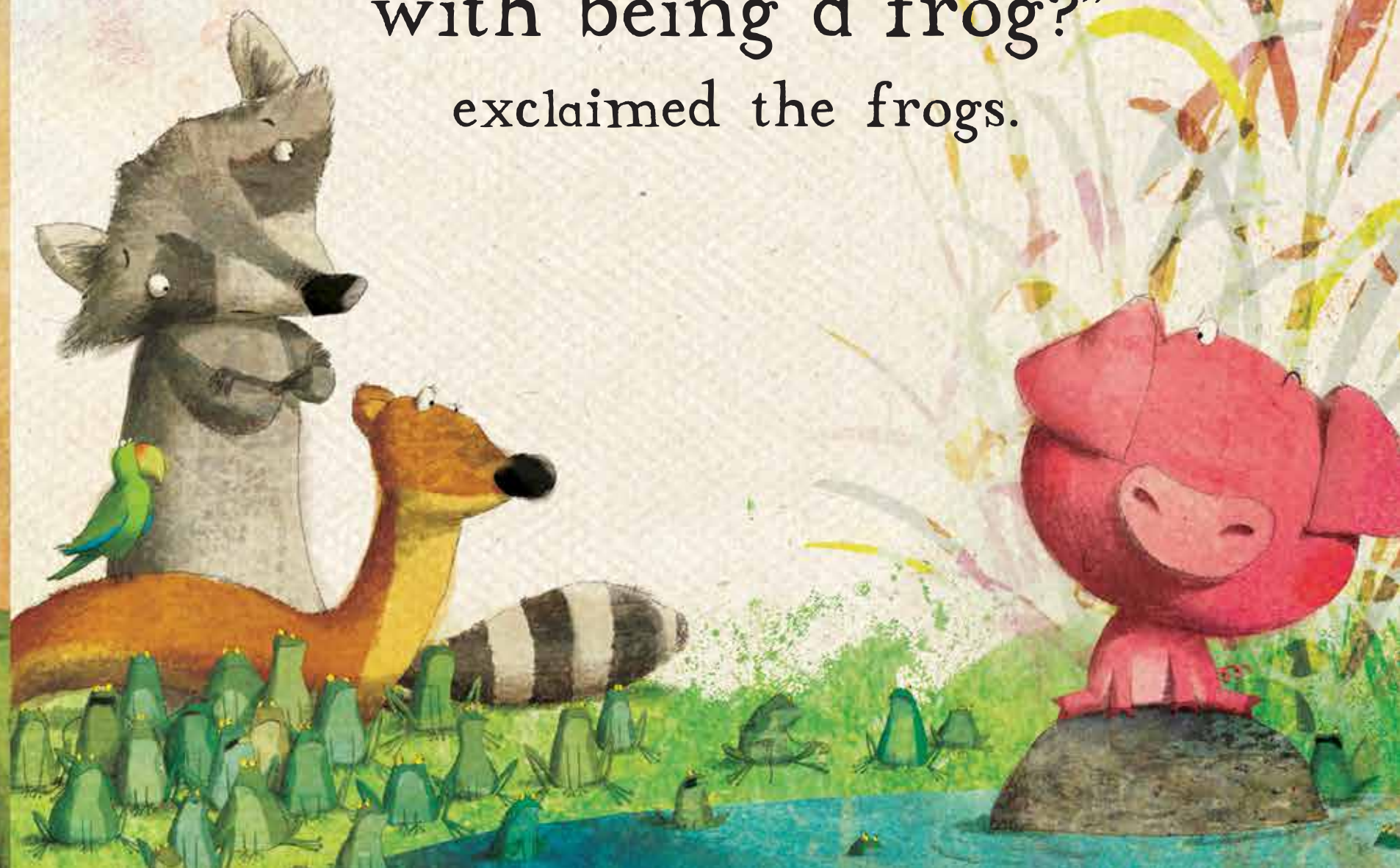
“He’s no relation
